TOWN OF KINNICKINNIC

MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN

A. <u>Purpose:</u>

This municipal plan has been developed to provide procedures for the Town of KinnicKinnic government to follow and respond to various types of emergencies or disasters that may affect the community. It provides a link to procedures that will be used by county government since the Town Of Kinnickinnic is part of the county emergency management program. This municipal plan is to be used in conjunction with the St. Croix County Emergency Operations Plan (EOP). The municipal plan will be maintained in accordance with current standards of the St. Croix County EOP and in accordance with municipal government. Review of this municipal plan shall be accomplished concurrently with the county plan.

B. SITUATIONS AND ASSUMPTIONS

Several types of hazards pose a threat to the lives, property or environment of St. Croix County. Some of these hazards include:

Severe Weather: Tornado, Straight Line Winds, Lightening, Blizzards, Ice Storm.

Flooding: Local Heavy Rain, Down Stream Flash Floods.

Fires: Man Made, Wild Fire.

Disease-(people-animals): Communicable, Air Borne, Water Borne.

Hazardous Materials: Transportation Accidents, Aviation, Commercial.

Energy Shortage: Supply Oriented, Storm Related either Local or Countywide.

Terrorism: Threat of War related incidents may be related to; Nuclear, Biochemical, or Conventional Attack.

A complete listing of these hazards are outlined in the St. Croix County Hazard Analysis. A copy of this is located in the County Emergency Management Office.

C. CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS

Municipal officials have primary responsibilities for disasters which take place in the municipality. They will activate the appropriate municipal agencies to deal with the disaster. The chief elected municipal official or the County Municipal Emergency Management Director is responsible for coordinating the response of municipal agencies and coordinating the response with county officials if county assistance is necessary.

- (1) Town of KinnicKinnic Chairperson shall assess the nature and scope of the emergency or disaster.
- (2) If the situation can be handled locally, do so using the procedures in this plan as appropriate.
 - a. The County Emergency Management Director advises the Town of KinnicKinnic Chairperson of the nature and extent of the emergency or disaster if known.
 - Town of KinnicKinnic Chairperson declares a local state of emergency and notifies the County/Municipal Emergency Management Director of this action.
- (3) If municipal resources become exhausted or if special resources are required, request county assistance through County/Municipal Emergency Management Director.
- (4) If assistance is requested, the County/Municipal Emergency Management Director assesses the situation and makes recommendations to the Town of Kinnickinnic Chairperson.
- (5) If assistance is requested, the County/Municipal Emergency Management Director will do the following (to the extent possible)
 - a. Activate the County EOC, which is located at 1101 Carmichael Road in the lower level (Community Room) of the St. Croix County Government Center.
 - b. Implement the county EOP.
 - c. Respond with county resources as requested.
 - d. Activate mutual aid agreements, if not already activated.
 - Coordinate county resources with municipal resources.
 - f. Notify Wisconsin Emergency Management (WEM) Regional Director.
 - g. Forward Uniform Disaster Situation Report (UDSR) form to the State.
 - h. Assist municipality with prioritizing and allocating resources.
- (6) If municipal and county resources are exhausted, the County/Municipal Emergency Management Director can request State aid through WEM.
- (7) If State assistance is requested, the WEM Administrator in conjunction with the Regional Director and County/Municipal Emergency Management Director assess the disaster or emergency situation and recommend what personnel, services and equipment be made available for response, mitigation or recovery if needed.
- (8) The WEM Administrator notifies the Governor and makes recommendations.
- (9) If State assistance is granted, procedures will be followed as stated in the Wisconsin EOP and County EOP.

E. RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

Additional support for St. Croix County Departments may be requested through the County/Municipal Emergency Management Office.

SUPPORT FROM STATE AND FEDERAL AGENCIES

Information and assistance in securing State and Federal support may be obtained by contacting the St. Croix County/Municipal Director. Request for National Guard assistance should be channeled through the County/Municipal Emergency Director to the WEM Regional Director to WEM Administrator.

F. PLAN DEVELOPMENT AND MAINTENANCE

The Town of Kinnickinnic EOP Development Team is composed of representatives from the Town Board. They are responsible for developing and maintaining this plan.

This Team meets on an as-need basis or as determined by the Town of Kinnickinnic Chairperson. The Team reviews incidents, changes, and new information and makes revisions on this plan, every year at the American Meeting in April. May

The Team also conducts after-action reviews of all exercises and major incidents.

G. LINE OF SUCCESSION

The Town of Kinnickinnic line of succession with authority to act on behalf of the Town of Kinnickinnic in the event of natural or man-made disasters or emergencies.
