

ORDINANCE NO. 2007- 01  
TOWN OF KINNICKINNIC

FIREWORKS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Sec. 167.10(5), Wis. Stats., permits local regulation of the local prohibition and/or regulation of the sale, possession or use of fireworks; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Kinnickinnic deems it expedient and necessary to regulate the sale, possession or use of fireworks in the Town of Kinnickinnic;

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Kinnickinnic DOES HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1. The term "fireworks" as used herein shall include all items referred to in the introduction of §167.10(1) and anything referred to under §167.10(1) (e), (f), (l), (j), (k), (i), (m) and (n) Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. No person or entity may sell, possess or use fireworks in the Town of Kinnickinnic without issuance of a user's permit from the Chair of the Town; provided, however, the Chair may issue a permit for the possession or use of fireworks in a total quantity at any one premises where the gross weight of the fireworks does not exceed 25 pounds and only to those persons or entities described in §167.10(3)(c), Stats. Further, no permit shall be necessary for the items referred to in §167.10(1)(e), (f), (l), (j), (k), (i), (m) and (n) where the collective gross weight of the said items on the premises does not exceed 25 pounds.

Section 3. This Ordinance does not prohibit the transport of fireworks to a City, Town, Village or County where the possession of the transported fireworks is authorized by permit or ordinance. The provisions of Section 2 prohibiting sale, possession or use of fireworks apply to a person transporting fireworks if, in the course of transporting fireworks through the Town, the person remains in the Town for a period of at least 12 hours.

Section 4. Any person violating this ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$500.00 nor more than \$1,000.00 per day, plus costs.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
